2016 Budget Approved

No Increase in Assessment Rates!

The HCA Board of Directors approved the 2016 Budget as submitted by Staff. The approximate \$2M Budget recognizes the need to continue with upgrades of the Community Center (36 years young) but the Board emphasized - that this can be done without an increase in the yearly assessments.

Executive Director Dave Grove announced that in 2016, plans are to complete the upgrades of Locker Rooms; refinish the Tennis Courts; extend the Overflow Parking Lot; widen the Traffic Circle in front of the Center; continue the repairs of the concrete pathways; add additional security features. In addition, the Board is looking into adding a Steam 'Room' at the Pool deck plus adding a room above the current Strength Weight Room (previously a racket ball court). As the number and type of Programs continues to grow, we are experiencing "growing pains" as we try to meet the needs of our Members.


