



NO INCREASE IN ASSESSMENTS

Lester Gross Award Call for Nominations

During their October 25, 2005 Meeting, the Harbison Community Association Board of Directors voted to establish the "Lester Gross Harbison Community Association Award". The Award recognizes the accomplishments of outstanding individuals who have made substantial and distinctive contributions to the betterment of the Harbison Community. These contributions shall demonstrate service, leadership, and vision which are symbolic of Lester's service to the Harbison ideal. In the February, 2013 Board meeting, the Board enlarged the eligibility to state "...individuals and/or organizations....".

It is now time to start the nomination process for a 2017 candidate. Past or present HCA Members may submit a letter of nomination and supporting documentation to Dave Grove prior to the next regular Meeting of the Board of Directors, on February 28, 2017.

To be eligible for nomination the individual and / or organization must have:

1. Lived or worked in the Harbison Community or served as a volunteer in service to Harbison
2. Actively contributed energy, time, talent, resources, and / or support to the Community. Once selected, the individual(s) shall be honored during the Annual Meeting of the Harbison Community Association in April. Recognition shall include the following:

Presentation from the HCA Board properly honoring the inductee(s)

Placement of the inductee's name or organization's name on a permanent "Lester Gross Harbison Community Service Award" plaque to be on display in the Community Center Lobby.

Covenant Enforcement & Patrolling

For 2017, increased emphasis will be placed on Covenant enforcement and patrolling of the HCA areas. If Owners do not take proper care of their property - their property's value may be diminished. HCA Covenants help to maintain and enhance property values. When someone sees vehicles parked on yards instead of in the drive-way or on the street; trash containers left for days at the curb; an unfavorable image may be formed that reflects on the entire neighborhood. HCA officials will be patrolling more often - and when violations are noted, Owners will be notified - and given an opportunity to correct the situation. If the violations remain, HCA will take corrective action which may mean fines and additional expenses to the Owner if HCA Maintenance personnel are involved. Please contact Ray Cloutier in Covenants at 781-2281 if any Owner has a question about a situation involving their property.

Effective January, HCA resumed patrolling of HCA areas, after the expiration of a contract with Allied Barton Security. During normal business hours Monday - Friday, HCA has 7+ personnel working outside in various common areas so we believe we have adequate coverage during that time period. In the afternoon and evening, 2-3 employees will be patrolling the pathways, streets and within the Community Center. While HCA personnel do not have the authority to apprehend, their presence can act as a deterrent and they can quickly communicate with local law enforcement officials. If there is a need for HCA to look into any situation, please contact the Front Desk at 781-2281 and a message will be relayed by a Staff Member to the employees patrolling. Disposition of Trash / Debris/ Household Items

We have noticed an increased frequency of items being discarded on Public / County road right-of-ways (mattresses, TVs, other appliances, yard debris) and remaining there for many days. In some cases, this "dumping" has occurred on property owned by the Association.

This is not only a violation of the Harbison Covenants, **Section 11.07. Disposition of Trash and Other Debris**, but also a violation of Richland County Ordinance, **Section 12-1. Dumping within rights-of-way prohibited**, Lexington County Ordinance **Section 66-343** and South Carolina Law, **Section 16-11-700**. Dumping litter on private or public property prohibited and subject to \$1,000 fine. Besides being illegal in some cases, dumping of these items is very disheartening - as the practice tarnishes the image of the entire neighborhood.

We know from experience that the material is not readily removed by the County. What are your impressions / thoughts when you see a discarded wet mattress or old TV set on a public right-of-way - especially after it has been there for days or weeks!!!!

Section 12.1 states very clearly “....it shall be unlawful for any person to dump, throw, drop, leave, or in any way deposit any garbage, ashes, rubbish, paper, trash, litteron any property belonging to another on or along any street, road, highway, curb, sidewalk, or public right-of-way except as required by the authorizedgarbage collector....”. Harbison Community Association - with the assistance of concerned neighbors, will monitor these situations. If a violation is observed, the Association may encourage local authorities to prosecute offenders to the fullest extent of the law.

PRE- REQUISITES (required for both Certification and Recertification):

- Must be 15 years of age with a mature and dependable character
- Able to swim 300 meters (12 lengths) continuously, using freestyle and breast stroke
- Starting in the water, candidates swim approximately 20 meters using freestyle or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10- pound object, return to the surface, kick 20 meters back to the starting point while maintaining two hands on the object and exit the water without using the ladder or steps (1 minute, 40 second time limit)
- Able to tread water for 2 minutes without the use of arms or hands

Upon completion of the course, participants will receive two-year certifications for:

- American Red Cross Lifeguarding
- American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer
- American Red Cross First Aid
- American Red Cross AED (Automated External Defibrillator)
