**Thanks** - to all Owners who have paid their 2018 Assessments! As a non-profit, Harbison Community Association's funding comes almost entirely from Assessments. We do not receive any funds from outside sources, so prompt payment allows the Association to offer various services as budgeted.

For those Owners who have not paid their 2018 fees, please remember that the deadline is June 30, 2018. Any balances after that date become delinguent with a 12% late charge added. In addition, it is probable that a Lien and/or Court Judgment will be filed due to the delinguency with court, legal, and administrative charges added to the account.

#### **Tree Removal**

The following is required per the Covenants: any tree, live or dead, over 4" in diameter in Harbison, regardless of the location, requires prior approval by a Harbison employee before it can be removed. This can be done by completing a tree removal request online at www.harbisonhca. com, at the front desk of the Community Center, or, in emergency situations, calling the Center at (803) 781-2281. Tree removal requests are typically processed in 24 - 48 hours.

#### **Projects - Update**

Dave Grove announced that mirrors and a ballet barre have been installed in the new dance room with cubicles for purses, water bottles, etc. A clock and some stereo speakers will be added soon. Plans are underway to install an outside wall monitor. The monitor will allow dance instruction to proceed without causing disruption to the participants or instructor. Benches will be provided for members and parents to be seated while viewing the dance activities on the monitor screen.

Renovation of the Front Lobby counter has been completed which improved security and gave Staff more room, which was greatly needed. Again, HCA employees performed the work.

A lot of maintenance activity will now shift to outside projects: improving trail bridges, tree removal as needed, concrete trail repairs, mowing, weeding, blowing of trail debris, etc.

In addition, HCA is building several small bookcases to be placed in some of the apartment complexes. With the bookcases, HCA is hopeful that the apartments will start a mini lending library for their tenants with the "take a book, leave a book" concept. To kick start this project, the Chapin Library donated over 100 books for children which were delivered to Harbison Garden Apartments.

The remaining Racquetball Court will be converted to a Functional Fitness Center later this year. Due to inactivity (less than 5 members use the court on a weekly basis), HCA believes the space can easily be converted to support activities that appeal to various age groups.

2019 possible projects include the addition of a new spa with a cold water plunge pool, sauna, and steam room. A contractor is developing cost estimates and, if constructed in 2019, the three facilities would be located on the pool deck in the vicinity of the current baby pool.

#### **Curb Appeal**

Having great curb appeal can increase the value of a property and draw more potential buyers. Buyers generally look for homes that have been well-maintained, and good curb appeal may encourage them to stop and want to see the inside of a home. Likewise, poor curb appeal may drive potential buyers away to other properties or neighborhoods. Take a look at the cover photo of this newseltter - the beautifully manicured lawn is more inviting than a poorly landscaped yard with vehicles parked on the grass and will garner the interest of more buyers.

Harbison's Covenants are designed to assist owners in maintaining and increasing property values. Vehicles parked on front lawns, that are disabled, or have out of date registration do not encourage buyers to stop and look at a home for sale. Vehicles parked on the grass in front yards constitute the most frequent covenant violation. Our DDRC (Design Development Review Committee) is in the process of developing a covenant enforcement and fine schedule which will outline the various steps that the Association will take to enforce covenant violations. All owners of property are subject to the covenants, and owners are liable for their respective users (tenants/occupants) for compliance. The schedule will list daily fines to address violations - including parking on non-paved surfaces. HCA intends to assist owners in maintaining and enhancing their curb appeal, and the fine schedule (to be announced later) is a step in that direction.
